

Standing Rock Sioux Tribe

Anyone who wishes to file a complaint regarding Sitting Bull College may contact the Office of the Standing Rock Sioux Clerk of the Court at Building 51, Proposal Ave. Fort Yates, ND 58538; Phone: 701.854.3807. Sitting Bull College is an independent agency of the Standing Rock Sioux Tribe with an autonomous governing system. However, all actions must be in accordance with the Standing Rock Sioux Tribal Constitution, under which the Standing Rock Sioux Tribal Court has the authority to resolve disputes involving Tribal members and non-members in accordance with Standing Rock Tribal laws, customs and traditions.

North Dakota State Board of Higher Education and South Dakota State Boards of Regents

In accordance with 34 CFR 600.9 State Authorization, Sitting Bull College has been determined to be authorized by name to offer educational programs beyond secondary education by the Standing Rock Sioux Tribe under:

“600.9 (a) (2) (ii) As defined in 25 U.S.C. 1802(2), an Indian tribe, provided that the institution is located on tribal lands and the tribal government has a process to review and appropriately act on complaints concerning an institution and enforces applicable tribal requirements or laws.”

Therefore, the North Dakota State Board of Higher Education and the South Dakota Board of Regents have no oversight authority for Sitting Bull College. Please see the information listed in the Standing Rock Sioux Tribe for complaints within the state jurisdiction.
